

Learning Resources, Facilities, and Equipment

1. Learning Resources.

Mechanism for providing and quality assurance of learning resources (textbooks, references and other resource materials, including electronic and web-based resources, etc.)

- Make statistics by preparing books that are updated annually and using an appropriate performance indicator.
- Requesting staff members to list the necessary references at the beginning of each year.
- Submitting courses on the notice board and the blackboard.

2. Facilities and Equipment

(Library, laboratories, medical facilities, classrooms, etc.).

- Appropriate facilities and equipment are available for teaching and learning like classrooms, Labs, Common room, Seminar room, etc.
- Each classroom is equipped with Smart Board and Projectors
- Titles of books are suggested at the beginning of the semester for the acquisition in the library.
- The Program receives adequate support from the central maintenance unit to maintain and upkeep classroom, offices and equipment.
- There is also a central store and a documented facility for the repair and replacement of the equipment.
- The demand and use of facilities and equipment are assessed on regular basis for the suitability of all stakeholders e.g. staff and students

3. Arrangements to Maintain a Healthy and Safe Environment

(According to the nature of the program)

- Learn about all areas of security and safety for the program.
- Spreading the culture of security and safety among students and faculty members through the work of many helpful instructions.

- Encouraging students to participate in maintaining the health and safety of the program environment
- Create and implement a contingency plan and an evacuation plan in the event of a danger.
- Fire evacuation policies and fire drills are practiced in all places
- The college has emergency plans, safety signs, emergency exit signs, and Lab Safety manuals.
